| Thesis Summary | This thesis paper presents an assessment of the neighbourhood hinged on Via Piave in Mestre, a useful case study for investigating the dynamic relationships between space and society in order to formulate sustainable urban regeneration strategies. This is an area conceived in the 20th century as a space of great quality, which today is contrasted by important phenomena of degradation. |

The research considered a participatory process, by listening to the resident population, which led to the definition of a methodological approach capable of highlighting the central issues that cause the perception of degradation and the consequent discomfort.

The proposed method involves subjecting intangible issues such as personal judgements on one's condition in the world and space to evaluation and measurement. By reading the latent factors, measured and causally related to each other by means of structural equation models, it was possible to identify relational assets as the key to a potential regeneration process.

The evaluation themes paved the way for a possible programmatic agenda for neighbourhood regeneration.
